#### Nomination Papers for Sorrento Town Officers are still available

Maine law requires that the nomination papers for elected Town Officials be available 100 days before the election and are due to be returned with the required signatures 60 days before the election. Unfortunately I didn't remind her of this important schedule and I apologize. The election for officers, will occur on November 8<sup>th</sup>. The open meeting portion of the Annual Town Meeting will still occur as usual on September 27<sup>th</sup>.

### Household Hazardous Waste Collection August 28th, 2021

Household Hazardous Waste Collection Day, August 28th, 2021 at the Ellsworth High School (299 State Street, Ellsworth) from 9:00 am to 1:00 PM. This collection will be for Liquid Materials hazardous waste only.

Disposal of up to 20 pounds or 5 gallons of liquid waste is available at no charge if registered at the Sorrento Town Office and a permit from the Town Office is brought to the collection site.

- Turpentine and Varnish
- Brake Fluid and Transmission Fluid
- Paint Thinners and Removers
- Charcoal and Lighter Fluids
- Pool Chemicals
- Anti-Freeze

- Adhesives and Solvents
- Oven/Drain Cleaners
- Fungicides and Herbicides/Pesticides
- Battery Acids & Muriatic Acid
- Linseed Oil
- Automobile Oil and Gasoline
- Rechargeable Batteries
