### 2017 DOG LICENSES

2017 Dog Licenses were due by January 1.
Starting February 1, you will pay a \$25 late fee per dog, along with the license fee.

\*\*Dogs must be licensed by January 1
or when they reach 6 months of age.

If you license your dog(s) <u>after January 31</u> (unless it is a new dog), you will pay a <u>\$25 late fee</u> per dog along with the license fee.

\*\*When licensing your dog, you must bring with you your dog's <u>rabies certificate showing the tag number</u> and <u>date of expiration</u> and your <u>certificate of proof of spay or neuter</u>, unless these are already on file at the Town Office.

\*\*If you lived and paid for your dog's license/tag in another town in Maine and now live in Sorrento, you must come in to the Town Office and exchange for a

Sorrento license/tag. There is no fee for this.

\*\*Any dog living in the Town of Sorrento must have a

Spayed/neutered dog fee - \$6.00 Unaltered dog fee - \$11.00

# COMMERCIAL BURN PERMITS RUN

OCTOBER 15 TO <u>APRIL 15</u>. ARREGUlar burn permits are available year-round.

# FOR BURN PERMITS ANY TIME OF THE YEAR:

You are required by Maine law to have a permit to burn, even for a small pile of grass clippings or leaves. A Forestry Warden will be called if you burn without a permit, possibly resulting in you being summonsed to court and fined.

The person who signs the fire permit is responsible for the fire. Do not leave any fire unattended.

### Required for burning:

- \*\*at least two adults to attend the burn,
- \*\*some form of water supply and hand tools must be on hand,
- \*\*and it is recommended you have a cellular phone or other communication device to call for assistance should the fire escape.

### FROM THE SULLIVAN WEEKLY BULLETIN, JULY 3, 1880

"We feel greatly obliged to Mrs. Chas. Allen for a basket of beautiful strawberries, kindly sent us this morning. The berries were raised on the farm of John U. Hill, Esq., and are the largest and finest we have seen in New England."

"We have recently been shown some samples of ore from the Custer Mine, which is the richest ore we have ever seen."

"At the inquest in the case of Mary E. Stover, Friday, June 25, the jury found that "the deceased came to her death between the 11<sup>th</sup> and the 14<sup>th</sup> days of June, A.D., 1880 by violence at the hands of some person or persons to them unknown." Signed James W. Patterson, Coroner (Mary was the daughter of Syllvanus Stover of Sullivan, now Sorrento)
